Temporary Living Structures

In the aftermath of the Black Forest Fire, El Paso County Development Services Department will be allowing the temporary use of RVs, motor homes, travel trailers, 5th wheels, and other wheeled living facilities. These types of structures do not require a building permit from the Regional Building Department provided they remain on wheels and are not permanently anchored. If the living facility is connected to temporary electric and / or gas the appropriate permits and inspections are required prior to the meter being set.

If you plan to move onto your property a manufactured/ factory built/ IRC/ HUD unit, regulated by the Colorado Division of Housing <u>click here</u>
