

Changes to how inspections by External Agencies are displayed

- On Permit Details, inspections performed by the Building Department will be listed first and inspections by external agencies will be listed in a separate table below that. This is to make it easier to identify and find inspections done by external agencies, which previously could be lost in a long list of Building Department inspections.
- The inspections that must be completed prior to getting a building final and Certificate of Occupancy remain the same.
- We are now listing both Blocking and non-Blocking required inspections. Blocking inspections will block the Certificate of Occupancy from being issued if they are not complete. Non-Blocking inspections also need to be complete, but you can complete them after the permit is finalized. Non-Blocking inspections are provided to make it easier for outside agencies to communicate their requirements to the person that pulled the permit.
- All inspections performed by a Utility company will now start with a "U". Previously, some started with a "P" which allowed them to be confused with Building Department plumbing codes.
- All inspection codes in Inspection History will now have a tooltip to identify them. Clicking the inspection code link will redirect to a full list of all inspection codes.
