### PROCEEDINGS:

Chairman Eddie Dunn called the meeting to order at 2:30 p.m.

#### 1. CONSIDERATION OF FEBRUARY 10, 2008 MINUTES

A motion was made by Dennis Hathcock to recommend **APPROVAL** of the February 10, 2009, Electrical Committee Minutes as written, seconded by Johnny Garcia; the motion carried unanimously.

#### 2. COMPLAINT UPDATES

- a) A complaint has been brought against Jesse Crookston, licensee for Adventure Electric, by Pikes Peak Regional Building Department for allegedly failing to correct deficiencies within 30 days and finalize six (6) Administratively Closed permits, in violation of Sections RBC105.9 and RBC109.2, 2005 Pikes Peak Regional Building Code. *Jesse Crookston appeared before the Electrical Committee on January 13, 2009 and February 10, 2009, and the Committee postponed this Complaint until the*

*March 10, 2009, Electrical Committee meeting to give Mr. Crookston an additional 30 days to complete the "A" status permits.*

Dean Wemmer appeared, was sworn in, and stated RBD has **WITHDRAWN** the Complaint.

- b) A complaint has been brought against James Frost, licensee for Sign Shop Illuminated, LLC, by Pikes Peak Regional Building Department for allegedly failing to correct deficiencies within 30 days and finalize one (1) Administratively Closed permit, in violation of Sections RBC105.9 and RBC109.2, 2005 Pikes Peak Regional Building Code. *James Frost appeared before the Electrical Committee on January 13, 2009 and February 19, 2009, and the Committee postponed this Complaint until the March 10, 2009, Electrical Committee meeting to give Mr. Frost an additional 30 days to complete the "A" status permits.*

Dean Wemmer appeared, was sworn in, and stated RBD has **WITHDRAWN** the Complaint.

- c) A complaint has been brought against Aaron Hamel, licensee for Laxson Electric Company, by Pikes Peak Regional Building Department for allegedly failing to correct deficiencies within 30 days and finalize three (3) Administratively Closed permits, in violation of Sections RBC105.9 and RBC109.2, 2005 Pikes Peak Regional Building Code. *Aaron Hamel failed to appear at the January 13, 2009, Electrical Committee meeting, and the Committee determined that a Letter of Reprimand be put in Mr. Hamel's license file, and recommended to the Board of Review that his Registration be suspended until the "A" status permits have been satisfactorily completed. Mr. Hamel appeared at the Board of Review meeting on February 18, 2009, and the Committee granted Mr. Hamel a 30-day extension to complete the "A" status permits, and requested that he reappear before the Board of Review at the March 18, 2009, meeting to give a status report regarding the "A" status permits. Mr. Hamel is appearing before the Electrical Committee today to request that the Letter of Reprimand be removed from his license file.*

Dean Wemmer appeared, was sworn in, and stated Mr. Hamel has one remaining "A" status permit to complete. Aaron Hamel appeared, was sworn in, and stated he was having a problem gaining access to the homes by the homeowners to complete the inspections. He said he did not receive the notice to attend the Electrical Committee meeting in January because of an error in the address RBD had listed for him. Mr. Hamel stated he appeared before the Board of Review in February, and the Committee granted him a 30-day extension to complete the permits, and he must reappear before the Board of Review in March to give the Committee a status report.

Dennis Hathcock stated it is Mr. Hamel's responsibility to notify RBD of a change of his business address. A motion was made by John Butler to **WITHDRAW** the Letter of Reprimand from Mr. Hamel's file, and to recommend to the Board of Review that Mr. Hamel's registration be reinstated, seconded by Dennis Hathcock; the motion carried unanimously.
