PROCEEDINGS:

Chairman Ed Dunn called the meeting to order at 2:35 p.m.

1. CONSIDERATION OF AUGUST 11, 2009 MINUTES

A motion was made by Waldo Pendleton to **APPROVE** the Minutes as written, seconded by Dennis Hathcock; the motion carried unanimously.

2. COMPLAINTS

There were no Complaints to discuss.

3. CONSENT CALENDAR

4. **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

- a) Discussion on the 2008 National Electric Code.

Dennis Hathcock stated he is against the adoption of the National Electric Code, mainly because of the cost for tamper proof receptacles and weatherproof receptacles. Dean Wemmer stated that these items are also in the 2011 National Electrical Code. Dennis Hathcock stated that the additional cost to the housing industry could be damaging at this time. Dean Wemmer stated he hopes to adopt the Code next spring, deferring some items if necessary. Ed Dunn stated we could run into problems by not implementing the Code as soon as possible. A motion was made by Waldo Pendleton to recommend to the Board of Review to adopt the 2008 National Electric Code, seconded by Dan McCully; the motion carried 3:1. Dennis Hathcock opposed.

5. **NEW BUSINESS**

- a) Code change language for contractor licensing requirements with regard to financial stability and ethics.

Dean Wemmer presented the language recommended for a Code change concerning contractors' financial stability and ethics. A motion was made by Ed Dunn to recommend to the Board of Review **DENIAL** of the proposed Code change, seconded by Waldo Pendleton; the motion carried unanimously.
