PROCEEDINGS:

Chairman Ed Dunn called the meeting to order at 2:35 p.m.

1. CONSIDERATION OF SEPTEMBER 8, 2009 MINUTES

Ed Dunn stated in sentence two of Unfinished Business, the word “also” should be “expected to remain.” A motion was made by Waldo Pendleton to **APPROVE** the Minutes as corrected, seconded by Dan McCully; the motion carried unanimously.

VARIANCE REQUESTS

4. 955 Space Center Drive, Permit H09614 – John Havick, Spectrum, Inc., requests a variance to Section 110.26, 2005 National Electrical Code, to allow a 22” working space width in front of the electric equipment where a minimum of 30” is required.

John Havick appeared and stated the project is a tenant finish with an existing electrical room. He said the electrical inspector asked for a disconnect to be added; and with the disconnect installed, there is 22” of working clearance available. A motion was made by Waldo Pendleton to recommend to the Board of Review **DENIAL** of the variance request because the Electrical Committee members found a solution to the problem, seconded by Dennis Hathcock; the motion carried unanimously.
