

## Notice: Fire Alarm Contractor Registration and System Installation Permit & Inspection

- A permit and rough inspection of all fire alarm systems is required.
- Fire Alarm System Contractors must be licensed by the Fire Authority and registered with Pikes Peak Regional Building Department.

### STATE STATUTE & 2005 PIKES PEAK REGIONAL BUILDING CODE

These new requirements comply with Colorado statute CRS 12-23-111(24), and are included in the 2005 Pikes Peak Regional Building Code that went into effect November 1, 2005. The state statute mandates permits and inspections of the electrical wiring for all fire alarm system installations. Although the state exempts fire alarm system contractors from licensing regulations, the Pikes Peak Regional Building Code requires contractors to register prior to obtaining permits for work in this jurisdiction. Licenses are granted by the fire authority. Regional Building Department facilitates the licensing program for Colorado Springs Fire Department. Please refer to Fire Alarm Contractor License packet available in the lobby and on this web site.

### TYPE OF SYSTEMS

Permits and rough inspections of electrical wiring are required for all fire alarm systems including new systems, remodels, and additions to existing systems. All types of system installations, from conduit piping to open wiring, are required to have a permit and inspection.

### INSPECTION COMPONENTS

The rough inspection will include verification of correct type of wiring, support and protection of wires.
