

## Top 10 Commercial Plumbing Changes 2021 IPC and Colorado State Amendments

Effective April 12, 2024 (This list does not include ALL changes)

- 1) State Amendment IPC Section 403.3 Non-Gendered Restrooms:
  - A new paragraph was added to the end of the section that says effective January 1, 2024: All state departments (excluding K-12 schools), state agencies, state institutions of higher education, counties, cities, or municipality buildings that are newly constructed or are being remodeled shall provide an ADA-compliant single-user or an ADA-compliant multi-user non-gendered restroom as required by section 9-5.7-103, C.R.S.
- 2) IPC Section 411.3 Water Heaters for Emergency Shower & Eye Wash Where water is supplied directly to an emergency shower or eyewash station from a water heater, the water heater shall comply with ASSE 1085.
- 3) IPC Section 412.5 Methods for Limiting Water Temperature to

  Bathtubs: Temperature limiting water heater must comply with ASSE 1082 or

  ASSE 1084.
- 4) IPC Section 412.10 Methods for Limiting Water Temperature to Head Shampoo Sinks and Footbaths: Temperature limiting water heater must conform to ASSE 1082.

- 5) **IPC Section 606.1 Individual Tenant Water Shut Off Valve:**In multiple tenant buildings, where a common water supply is installed, a main shut off valve shall be provided for each tenant.
- 6) IPC 705.2.4 and 705.10.4 PVC and ABS DWV Push Fittings: Push fittings must comply with ASME A112.4.4.
- 7) **IPC Section 717 Relining Building Sewers and Building Drains**: Limited to gravity drainage piping 4 inches and larger. Installation instructions and recorded video camera survey required.
- 8) IPC Section 1002.4.1.5 Fixture Drains Serving as Trap Priming

  Method: Fixture drains from a lavatory, hand sink or drinking fountain shall now serve as a method for providing a trap seal for an emergency floor drain, trench drain or floor sink.
- 9) State Amendment to IFGC Section 503.4.1 Plastic Piping: Add new sentence to the end of the section saying: Where installed as an exhaust vent for a gas fired water heater, the new plastic pipe shall be tested with 5 psi air pressure or 10 ft. head water column at the time of inspection prior to being connected to the water heater. See water heater handout.
- 10) State Amendment IPC Section 903.1.3 Protected Vent Terminal:

Change wording to read 4 inches instead of 2 inches. Section 903.1.3 Where an open vent pipe terminates above a sloped roof and is covered by either a roof-mounted panel (such as a solar collector or photovoltaic panel mounted over the vent opening) or a roof element (such as an architectural feature or a decorative shroud), the vent pipe shall terminate not less than 4 inches (102 mm) above the roof surface.
