PROCEEDINGS:

The Licensing Committee meeting was conducted in a hybrid form, allowing Committee members, Department staff, and the public to attend in person at the Pikes Peak Regional Development Center, 2880 International Circle, Colorado Springs, Colorado 80910, Hearing Room on the Upper Level, or virtually via a program called Microsoft Teams live events, which is accessible via Pikes Peak Regional Building Department's website Boards & Committees' page at: https://www.pprbd.org/Information/Boards.

1. CALL TO ORDER: DETERMINATION OF A QUORUM

Chair Steve Lepine called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

2. CONSIDERATION OF THE AUGUST 10, 2023 LICENSING COMMITTEE MINUTES.

A motion was made by Zachary Taylor to **APPROVE** the August 10, 2023 Licensing Committee Minutes as written; seconded by David Rojewski; the motion carried unanimously.

3. **COMPLAINT(S) UPDATE**

a) Heart Heating & Cooling, LLC

During the August 10, 2023 Licensing Committee meeting, a motion was made by Tim Toussaint to lift the suspension previously placed on Heart Heating & Cooling, LLC, so the company can obtain new permits, the suspension, however, is not to be lifted earlier than August 14, 2023, which is past the deadline for an appeal. Mr. Toussaint requested that Department staff provide an update to the Committee in September; seconded by Zachary Taylor; the motion carried unanimously.

Matthew Matzen provided the Committee with an update stating that, of the thirty A-Status permits Heart Heating & Cooling has remaining, nine permits have been accepted for CNC and are currently in the thirty-day waiting period. He said this leaves twenty-one pending permits, which Heart Heating & Cooling is diligently working through with the assistance of Luke Sanderson, the Senior Non-Compliance Inspector. He said that no other permits have been administratively closed.

The Committee will not require further update(s).

4. **CONTRACTOR COMPLAINT(S)**

Conduct of Hearing.

Rules. Hearings need not be conducted according to the technical rules relating to evidence and witnesses.

Oral Evidence. Oral evidence shall be taken only on oath or affirmation.

Hearsay Evidence. Hearsay evidence may be used for the purpose of supplementing or explaining any direct evidence, but shall not be sufficient in itself to support a finding unless it would be admissible over objection in civil actions in courts of competent jurisdiction in this State.

Admissibility of Evidence. Any relevant evidence shall be admitted if it is the type of evidence on which responsible persons are accustomed to rely in the conduct of serious affairs, regardless of the existence of any common law or statutory rule that might make improper the admission of any evidence over objection in civil actions in courts of competent jurisdiction in this State.

Exclusion of Evidence. Irrelevant and unduly repetitious evidence shall be excluded.

Rights of Parties. Each party shall have these rights among others:

- 1. To call and examine witnesses on any matter relevant to the issues of the hearing;
- 2. To introduce documentary and physical evidence;
- **3.** To cross-examine opposing witnesses on any matter relevant to the issues of the hearing;

- **4.** To impeach any witness regardless of which party first called to testify;
- **5.** To rebut the evidence against the party;
- 6. To represent the party or to be represented by anyone of the party's choice who is lawfully permitted to do so.
- a) A complaint has been brought against Bridger Gene Kucinski, Examinee for Go Freedom Ventures, dba K2 Homes, LLC, by Pikes Peak Regional Building Department, for not obtaining a temporary certificate of occupancy (TCO) or a certificate of occupancy (CO) for the property located at 1255 S. 26th Street, Colorado Springs, Colorado, prior to allowing occupancy in violation of Sections RBC110.1.1 and RBC201.11.3.1 and 6, Pikes Peak Regional Building Code (the "Code"), 2017 Edition, as amended.

Virjinia Koultchitzka advised the Committee, as follows: the complaint was filed by Pikes Peak Regional Building Department ("RBD") with a resulting summons to Bridger Gene Kucinski, Examinee for Go Freedom Ventures, dba K2 Homes, LLC, for not obtaining a temporary certificate of occupancy (TCO) or a certificate of occupancy (CO) for the property located at 1255 S. 26th Street, Colorado Springs, Colorado, prior to allowing occupancy. The governmental agency withholding approval(s) for TCO was the City of Colorado Springs, and more specifically City Engineering. The City of Colorado Springs issued a Stop Work Order ("SWO") dated June 29, 2023. After this matter was originally scheduled for appearance before the Committee on August 10, 2023, it was administratively continued by RBD to allow the interested parties an opportunity to resolve outstanding issues. As a result, a TCO was issued on September 6, 2023, with an expiration date of October 6, 2023. While the attachments to the complaint include the site plan, a plat, drainage letter, and soils and foundation investigation and geologic hazards evaluation, most of these documents are relevant to the issues holding up the TCO with City Engineering, and therefore, considered moot for the remaining Code violations: Sections RBC110.1.1 and RBC201.11.3.1 and 6.

Bridger Gene Kucinski appeared in person and was sworn in. Matthew Matzen, as present, was sworn in. Luke Sanderson was also present and sworn in.

Mr. Matzen presented the complaint. The home located at 1255 S. 26th Street, Colorado Springs, Colorado was occupied prior to obtaining a TCO or a CO. At the time RBD learned of the occupancy of the residence, all RBD inspections had been completed, except a partial from an outside reviewing agency, City Engineering. Mr. Sanderson performed a site visit which confirmed the subject occupancy prior to a TCO or a CO. An approval for TCO was not issued by City Engineering until September 5, 2023, which a resulting TCO issuance on September 6, 2023. Public improvements have not been completed, nor has a construction plan been submitted for approval. "GEC issues need to be resolved prior to CO."

Luke Sanderson confirmed that during his site visit on July 12, 2023, he spoke with the owner of said property as well as the contractor to confirm no TCO or CO had been obtained. He also confirmed that City Engineering had a partial inspection remaining before a CO can be issued.

Mr. Kucinski provided three-pages of exhibits: a Certificate of Occupancy (Temporary Residential), i.e., a TCO, dated September 6, 2023, as Exhibit A; a Timeline of Events prepared by Mr. Kucinski, as Exhibit B; and a partial RBD printout of the Inspection History of said property, as Exhibit C. With regard to the admissibility of said exhibits, Ms. Koultchitzka objected to Exhibit B after Mr. Kucinski confirmed on record that he will testify to the subject timeline.

Mr. Kucinski testified that there was a partial engineering inspection in April of 2023, which indicated "In progress: ok for TCO, pending public improvements from DP dated March 2019." He further stated that the building final was passed on June 27, 2023. He admitted that this was his error in misunderstanding that a TCO was a different process than the CO.

Ms. Koultchitzka confirmed with Mr. Matzen that the contractor portal, which is available through RBD's website, does provide contractor access to request a TCO, which can also be accomplished over the telephone or by visiting the Department personally.

A motion was made by Zachary Taylor to place a One-Year Incident Report in the files of Bridge Gene Kucinski, as the examinee, and Go Freedom Ventures, dba K2 Homes, LLC, for allowing occupancy of 1255 S. 26th Street, Colorado Springs, Colorado prior to obtaining the required TCO or CO; seconded by Toby Conquest; the motion carried unanimously.

Ms. Koultchitzka provided Mr. Kucinski with his appeal rights pursuant to RBC101.7 of the Code, verbally, as well as providing a printed copy of the Notice of Appeal Rights, 2017 Edition of the Code. Further, she stated the Department has authority, pursuant to Section RBC103.12 of the Code, to issue administrative fines; the Department retains such right, and fines(s) may be imposed.

5. CONSENT LICENSE REQUESTS

Consent license requests will be acted upon as a whole unless a specific item is called for discussion by a Committee member or a citizen wishing to address the Committee.

The following committee members: Chair Steve Lepine, Zachary Taylor, and David Rojewski disclosed actual conflict(s) of interest with the license request of Nor'wood Limited, Inc., Scott Norman. As a result, this license request was heard under Item 6 of the Agenda (Items Called off the Consent Calendar).

David Rojewski advised that he has a conflict of interest with Vantage Homes Corp., fka Vantage Homes Corporation, Chad Thurber. As a result, this license request was heard under Item 6 of the Agenda (Items Called off the Consent Calendar).

Zachary Taylor advised of a letter of reference issued to Kenney Konstruction LLC, James Kenney. However, after further discussion, the matter was not determined to be a conflict of interest; therefore, this license request remained on the Consent License Requests.
